The MSW recycling industry in Texas currently has a \$7.8 BB annual positive impact to the states' economy. It can sustainably become a \$20 BB industry. Texans now recycle more than 13 MM tons annually (27%), but could recycle an additional 50% of the 33 MM tons we continue to landfill each year. More than 31,000 Texans are employed in the industry. Economic and job growth opportunities are available if we pursue them. Infrastructure growth at the local level is central to the opportunity.
