- Used by TECRO, TECO
- Payment in TECRO or TECO's name
- Individual pictured need not be present



OWL symbol
No restrictions on
purchases.
Valid only for
official purchases.

TAX EXEMPTION CARDS FOR PERSONAL PURCHASES

- Not transferable
- Any form of payment acceptable
- For use by and benefit of individual pictured



EAGLE symbol
No restrictions on
purchases.
Valid for personal
purchases by
cardholder only.
